Title IX

- Have future First-Years do more than a 45 minute Training Video about Sexual Assault, Consent, Drugs, and Alcohol before they come to Allegheny.
- Update the General Incident Report Form to include “Sexual Harassment” as a type of report instead of just Bias, Grievance, and Incident Report.

COVID

- Create unofficial support groups for those feeling isolated and alone.
- Create an official Allegheny “Gator Aid” job for those with cars to help other students get groceries or go to places in general.
- Allow students to have the choice of using Munch Money or Meal Swipes for McKinley’s and Brooks.

Campus Resources:

- Have Allegheny provide a list of trustworthy websites where they can buy cheaper textbooks.
- Make dorm bathrooms more accessible for students with disabilities.
- Allow students to go to therapy for free more than once a month.
- Have Campus Security connect to apps such as “Noonlight” so students will have help with a press of a button. It is more portable than Call Boxes.
